RV Park Rules

In an attempt to make your stay pleasurable, Clover Pass Resort has established some park rules that we ask all of our customers to follow. If you have any questions or concerns regarding any of these rules, please contact the resort manager.

- ┌ Rent is due upon check in. Monthly renters may pay their rent monthly on the first of each month.
- ┌ Check out time is 12:00 p.m. unless other arrangements are made with the office staff.
- ┌ Changing campsites must be approved by the office.
- ┌ Campers' vehicles must either be parked within their campsite without blocking other traffic, or in the parking lot. Empty campsites are not available for parking vehicles.
- ┌ Each camper is responsible for placing their garbage in the dumpster.
- ┌ All pets must be kept on a leash. Campers are responsible for cleaning up after their pets.
- ┌ Showers and the coin operated laundry are for resort guests only.
- ┌ Washing cars, trailers, RV's, or other wasteful uses of water are not permitted.
- ┌ Quiet time in the park is from 10:00 p.m. til 7:00 a.m.
- ┌ Campground speed is 10 MPH.
- ┌ No clotheslines are allowed.
- ┌ No open fires are allowed.
- ┌ Each campsite is allowed one plug-in freezer. Additional freezers will be charged \$10 per month.
- ┌ Slideouts, tipouts, awnings, etc. cannot encroach on adjacent campsites. All campsites are clearly marked. Please ensure that your belongings stay within your campsite boundary.

RV Safety

Clover Pass Resort is committed to the safety of our guests. Please be cautious when driving in and out of the park. Watch for children, park guests, and resort equipment. We ask that guests maintain a speed under 10 MPH while inside the park. Other safety considerations include making sure electrical and sewer lines are in good repair, inspecting your pedestal to make sure that receptacles are in good repair, and making sure that your RV is completely disconnected before moving. Please report any problems with your electric or water service to the office immediately. In addition, asking for someone's help to assist you in getting in and out of your campsite is always a great idea, especially when it entails backing up.
