

Charter Fishing

Many of our resort guests enjoy a day of charter fishing for salmon and halibut. If you would like to arrange a charter, the resort manager will assist you by making the arrangements. Most boats comfortably accommodate 4 to 6 guests for this all day fishing excursion. Generally speaking, the day's catch is equally split between those participating in the charter. Guided charter fishing is approx. \$250 per person per day. Advance reservations for charters can be arranged by contacting the resort and paying a deposit.

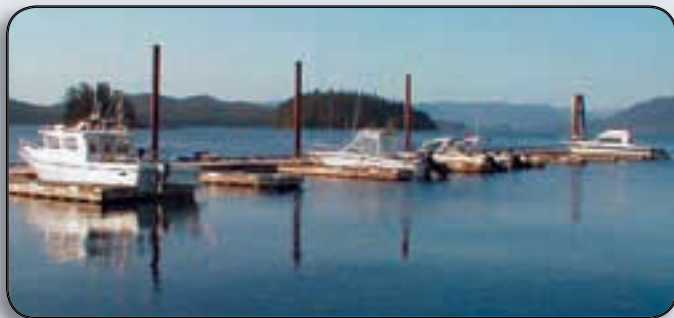


Fish Processing

Clover Pass Resort is happy to offer custom fish processing and freezing for our guests. Our processing services include filleting, vacuum packing, freezing, and boxing your catch. We also offer fish smoking services for guests who are interested in having some of their catch smoked. Please ask the office for current pricing if you are interested in our processing services.

Moorage

Clover Pass Resort has a 40 slip marina that can accommodate both skiffs and larger boats. RV guests who bring their boats can rent moorage space by the day, week or month. The daily rates for boats up to twenty four feet is \$8.50 per day. If you are interested in moorage, please contact our office.

Remember, fresh & smoked salmon makes great gifts for neighbors, family members, friends, business associates or clients that couldn't make the trip. Shipping generally costs between \$1.50-2.50 per pound and is sent Federal Express Standard Overnight. Ask the resort manager for more information on purchasing or shipping fresh and/or smoked fish.
